## GED TESTING INFORMATION

Passing the General Educational Development Test (GED) qualifies candidates to receive a State of Florida High School Diploma. The examination consists of five competency areas and is administered over two testing sessions. The maximum testing time for the complete examination is approximately 7½ hours. Special editions and accommodations may be requested as needed.

Science	80 minutes
Social Studies	70 minutes
Language Arts – Reading	65 minutes
Mathematics	90 minutes

GED Testing will provide appropriate accommodations for GED candidates with documented disabilities in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)

To apply for accommodations, call Lake Technical Center, 352-589-2250, ext. 137, to schedule a private appointment time.

## TESTING REQUIREMENTS

The minimum age for GED testing is 18 on the date of the examination. Candidates who are 16 or 17 must do the following to be eligible for the GED test:

1. be **withdrawn** from high school
2. take the **Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE)**
3. attend **GED preparatory classes**
4. receive verification of completion skill levels from the classroom instructor (**Early Testing Waiver**)
5. provide a **hardship letter**
6. receive **written permission** from district personnel

All candidates must bring a valid driver's license, a valid passport or other form of government-issued identification that shows name, address, date of birth, signature and photograph. Candidates must pay a fee of \$70 in cash; **personal checks, debit cards and credit cards are not accepted.** Candidates who need to retest failed portions must pay a fee of \$14 per test. A social security card is needed to verify the candidate's social security number on the official GED transcript after testing but **is not required to take the test.**

Candidates for testing must attend the registration/orientation in person at the Lake Technical Center main campus, located at 2001 Kurt Street, Eustis, Florida, 32726.

Registration/orientation dates are scheduled for each month. Please check our web site at **[www.laketech.org](http://www.laketech.org)** for dates.

### Score Requirements:

A total of 2250 points with a minimum standard score of 410 on each section of the test is required to pass the GED.
