

Pre Employment Testing at Lake Tech Fire Academy (1565 Lane Park Cut Off Tavares, Fl. 32778) November 6, 2012

For the Leesburg Fire Department

Requirements:

- FF2/PM State of Florida certification,
- a valid Florida Drivers License,
- you must have completed the Leesburg application process, and
- be on the approved list.

Call Leesburg's Human Resources 352.728.9740 to apply. <mark>Once you have been approved by Leesburg, call Lake Tech</mark> <mark>at 352.742.6463 to sign up and pay for the test.</mark>

Test Overview:

The test is comprised of two parts, a written test and a physical agility test (PAT). The 100-question written test consists of 50 firefighter questions referenced to the IFSTA Essentials of Firefighting and Fire Department Operations, 5th edition, and 50 Pm questions referenced to the Pm National Registry Standards. The PAT is timed and applicants will be ranked according to the time it takes to complete the test as well as the written score. If you have taken the PAT within the last year, you do not have to retest unless you want to improve your score.

The PAT consists of 5 events, in full bunker gear, on air, and they are:

- 1. Hammer slide
- 2. Carrying a high rise pack (100 ft of 1 ¾ inch hose) to the 5th floor of the tower & down
- 3. Hoist a roll of 2 ½ inch hose to the 5th floor of the tower on a rope
- 4. Drag a 185lb rescue dummy 120 ft.
- 5. Pull a charged, 1 ¾-inch hose line 75 ft.

Lake Tech will provide Scott SCBAs, if needed. There will also be a limited number of bunker coats and pants available. Lake Tech encourages you bring your own NFPA-approved bunker gear. Applicants will have to provide their own gloves, hood, and boots. Arrive at least 15 minutes before your PAT to receive bunker gear. Scores will be given to the participating department for consideration when hiring new Firefighter/ Paramedics. The test scores will be good for one year.

Testing Fees/Dates:

- The testing fee is \$100, deadline for payment and registration is Nov. 2, 2012.
- The written and practical test date will be Nov. 6, 2012, at 8 am.
- PAT test will start at 9:30 am or immediately after the written test. You will be assigned a specific time slot when you complete the written portion of the test, unless you have made a previous appointment time due to travel distance to home. The PAT may extend into Nov. 7 according to the number of registered applicants.
