- 4. The student must write a short essay explaining why he/she selected the particular program of study and career field.
- 5. The student must have a recommendation from one of her/his high school instructors.
- 6. Applicant must have a minimum high school cumulative 2.0 grade point average.
- 7. The scholarship recipient is awarded tuition cost for the first semester. Awarding of the second semester tuition cost is based on the student maintaining satisfactory academic progress for the first semester as defined by the school's SAP policy.
