- Schedule your own convenient test time. Tests are offered multiple times a week, including Saturdays; and
- Take high quality job simulation tests in a standardized, fair testing environment.

Upon completion of the entry level exam and CPAT testing, all candidate scores are automatically forwarded to the Alachua County BoCC Human Resources Office. Candidates who attain a passing score on the physical abilities test will be placed on the Alachua County BoCC Fire Rescue department's referral list. The Alachua County BoCC Fire Rescue Department will contact candidates on the list and will invite them to continue to participate in other stages of the departmental selection process.

National Testing Network is a service provided to conduct entry level testing and CPAT testing in a standardized, professional environment. National Testing Network does not replace the Alachua County BoCC Fire Rescue Department's responsibility and decision making in the testing process. All candidate testing results are provided to Alachua County Board of County Commissioners Human Resources Office where the applicant's minimum qualifications, and certifications, are reviewed and submitted to the Fire Rescue Department.
