

Test of Essential Academic Skills - Version 6.0 (TEAS VI) Assessment

The assessment is mandatory for those entering into the EMT or LPN Program. The test contains 170 questions and includes Reading, Mathematics, Science and English and Language usage. **PHOTO IDENTIFICATION required.**

FOLLOW THE STEPS BELOW:

Step One: Apply to Lake Technical Center through our website (www.laketech.org) or at the school

Step Two: Create an account with ATI Testing. Website: www.atitesting.com

Step Three: Check in at the front desk in the Admissions lobby.

Monday 8 am to 4 pm or Wednesday 8 am to 1 pm.

Step Four: Pay testing fee for the TEAS test.

Each subtest has a separate time limit: The total testing time for the TEAS Assessment is 3 hours and 29 minutes.
