HAIKU DECK



Do your students roll their eyes whenever you pull out another PowerPoint?

Haiku Deck is a presentation tool that you can use on the web, on your iPad, or iPhone. Haiku Deck offers a variety of themes and templates and an integrated image search. You can add your own images or search through Haiku Deck's library of images. There are over 40 million free creative commons images in their image library AND a depository of presentations already made that you can "steal".

All presentations created on the web can be shared through Facebook, Twitter, and email or exported as PPT files. They can also be embedded into blog posts, webpages, and LMS. (Schoology)

Haiku Deck's iPhone and iPad apps allow you to use your phone or tablet as a teleprompter during presentations. Speaker notes are shown to you, but not to your audience while you are in presentation mode.
