I typically use Screencastomatic and only pay \$15/year for it. Screencasting is video creating by capturing your computer screen and audio at the same time. For instance, the videos I make for Deliberate Practice and some of my other "how to" videos are made with Screencastomatic.

Another good screencasting tool is called SnagIT, this is a Tech Smith technology, who also makes Jing and Camtasia Studio.
