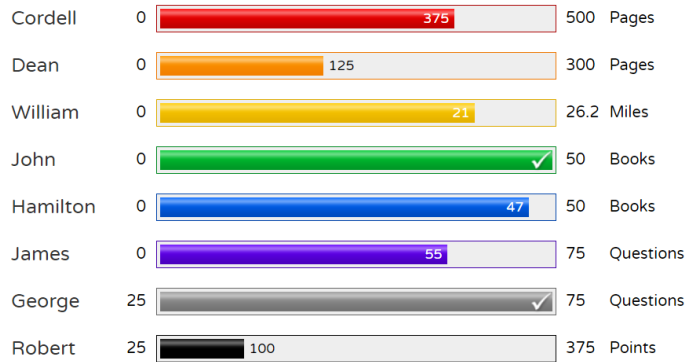


## Progress Chart using Google Sheets

This would be a great chart for your classroom wall in order to encourage competition.



### Want to Make Your Own Progress Indicator?

#### Step 1: Modify the Google Spreadsheet Template

- Make a copy of [this template](#). (You'll need to sign-in with your Google account.)
- Edit the **Progress** data.
  - Enter as many names as you wish.
  - Be sure the progress is greater than the start value and less than the end value.
  - Default bar color is gray if you don't specify a color.
- Change the title of your progress indicator by changing the name of the worksheet (at the bottom).

• **Do not edit any cell with a blue background.**

#### Step 2: Publish Your Spreadsheet

- Go to **File, Publish to the Web...**, then click **Publish**.

#### Step 3: Get Your Flippity.net Link

- Click on the **Get the Link Here** tab of the template (at the bottom).
- Click on the Flippity.net link to view the Progress Indicator bars.

#### Step 4: Bookmark and Share

- Bookmark the page to find it again quickly.
- Share the Flippity.net link with anyone you want to view the progress.
