

# Knowt

Knowt is an app that uses machine learning to automatically convert your notes into review quizzes. Knowt has iOS, Android, and web apps for this tool.

You create your notes on the app or upload your notes and Knowt analyzes them using machine learning. Their A.I. server then determines the best question formats for each sentence. Once it knows the best questions, the algorithm sends it to the web or mobile app for you to take a quiz. It creates three types of questions: multiple choice, fill in the blank, and explanation. You get great quizzes that are custom made from your notes.

You can create notes and develop quizzes for your students or your students can create their own from their own notes.

When I saw this at first, I didn't think it could possibly turn out quality questions.....but it did! Try it.

There is a learning curve, however, on creating notes. Look at the examples they have on the site.
