

Coronavirus Update from Lake County Schools/Lake Technical College

Lake County Schools (LCS) still has no confirmed cases of coronavirus among students or staff.

We continue to urge families to follow the <u>CDC's</u> <u>information for travel</u>, and please notify your child's principal if any member of your household has been to any of the countries where community spread of the virus is occurring. You can find the latest list of those countries on the <u>CDC web page</u>. Out of an abundance of caution, we ask that these children wait for the 14-day incubation period, beginning the day of return to the U.S., to expire before returning to school.

We are reminding all students and staff to follow the preventive measures outlined by the CDC:

- Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cough or sneeze into an elbow or use a tissue and place it immediately in the trash.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
